of likes followers or views when I have when I have more followers I'm like excited over like 3.5 followers It's like it's adorable because like honestly people that have 17 million can care less about 100,000 people liking their stuff more you know but like you care about every single one I love I love my friends How many bracelets do you have on uh between the both of you Oh that's a good question I have one You have three right I have two bracelets Basically 10210 I thought that was ok I thought that was I watch three bracelets between me and Kyle True Blood Um Michelle one day on your stream You should do a fun all summer dress and clothing show I would love to do that I I talk well not on this show but I would love to uh um and have them in your carousel I would love to do that We can do um all fun dresses and shoes and um all the fun things that I enjoy I can like accessories Like this bag you can get on Amazon but this bag is so cute How cute is this bag Look look at this bag This is the cutest It's so cute I get so many compliments on this bag Something on it There's something on it What Oh man So are you pregnant Because I'm definitely following you if you are not pregnant That is not fun That's not fun That's not fun to talk about Um Oh that's so sticky Cute Thank you Rosalinda I think so too Um and I have red shoes that match too but you can't see it Gosh I am not putting out there that I'm pregnant That is terrifying Um what musical artist am I ashamed that I use No Should it just be never Have I ever Ok Is that ok Um and Kyle can rate all the dresses so he doesn't get porn Kyle used to be a personal shopper at No Did you know that back in the day back in the heyday Um it's it's a poopy dress Not pre oh my God That's terrible It's poopy It's poopy guys Look it's got tears See I'm very tiny I'm super tiny Mostly tiny What what what look at the poof I can't believe like oh what the heck hilarious It has poops It has three layers I'm like a cupcake I'm like a cupcake I don't know I love the dress Looks cute on you Thank you Rosalinda I appreciate you Um how is your Friday going this so far And what are you up to this weekend Kyle Am I pregnant You'd be the first one to know right That one uh driven to a different town We have Easter dress Yes it does have like an Easter feel to it Oh yeah Never have it We're playing never have it ever now because we want you guys to get involved Can you be all right Have you ever driven without a license Has anyone ever driven without a license Have I Yes that's a yes Have you driven without a license before Uh when did you drive You have to get your license updated my friend Ok When did you drive without a Oh I mean um oh he doesn't have a license Um I forgot the my license uh at home one day Ok Ok You mean like without a without a no for

your at home without a license Have you driven without a license Uh yeah
How old were you 14 Wow Where did you go We went across town to visit
some friends uh when we were freshman in high school and my friend took
his mom's car um and we all drove it Wow Wow Wow Wow Me Melinda
Melanie Are you watching Melanie Are you watching Kyle's mom Melanie
is gonna come on the show uh in March We March When is she coming on
We never took my mom's car but did she know this story She might not Well
yeah Kyle I don't get it either Um let's play it let's ask another card Ok let's
ask another question Um make sure you like play in the chat with us You
never know we might have a giveaway So make sure you hit that follow
button Um we've had some really great giveaways in the past Um maybe you
shouldn't tell the story Hilarious What do we got all of these We can't talk
about wait why not why why not here Read them out and let me know if any
of these we can actually talk about No I can read you can read that Ok Has
anyone hooked up with someone and kept it a secret from their friend Yes

gonna lie Um no way Ok cool Um let someone take pictures of me Uh not
with clothes on That's a negative Wait Really I feel like that would be a yes
for you I don't know where those pictures are gonna end up You can't do that
I took and I tuck and dance in front of the mirror all the time I'm sorry It's so
funny Worn a wonder Bra Kyle What have I worn A wonder bro I will say
yes I will say yes to that question Um uh call the number graffiti in the
bathroom Oh that's weird No Oh coffee being coming in hot Thank you so
much 000 ok It's so far so close so close so far dated someone because they
had money dated someone because they had money No I never dated

someone because they had money But um it was a nice perk that they did have a nickname for my special parts Ok No Ok We getting we're getting too Yeah Yeah Yeah Yeah Yeah Listen don't go anywhere We've got a very special guest Mr Harris Oh wait Oh wait not yet Oh I got so excited one time I just wanna get Ok Ok Ok Ok Ok So as you can tell this is a live show So thank you so much for tuning in for the chat Um with someone is part horse is part horse You just never know what you get on a Friday right Um let's see what else do we have Um ok So you've been taken away from a bouncer had Ok I did I did I did I did this is a funny story Um I was in college and uh uh I had an ID made and even though I'm not like a big crazy drinker I just wanted to go to this bar with my friends They all had fake I DS made and my ID was a California ID believe it or not And like I remember showing it to him and I must have looked like I was like 12 because like he looked at me and he was like yeah no he looked at me and I was like no no no no And I was like what I'm from California and he goes really What part And I was like the sunny part the sunny part I didn't get it and he took it away that \$50 No Was it being a smart ass I was just so part is not a smart ass answer No I was because I couldn't I didn't know what part it was I didn't know I didn't know California very well taken away Too because I couldn't remember the birthday You can remember the birth of my fake ID of your fake I day And what was it 9 11 Oh no that was the that was the birthday How could you how could you forget that birth No Uh these questions are PG now Well we want to keep them PG Kind of um I went out one night with 1000 bucks in my pocket It was totally crazy That sounds totally crazy Yeah Um Michelle you were supposed to say um I should read them first and then Oh yeah Yeah Yeah Yeah I should read Oh I don't expect anything is gonna be bad Yeah I know I know I I listen I listen to you I do have to be careful What other questions do we have Can you put this in there Sure Question the moon landing No but you do because you're I only question it because it's become like a big conspiracy theory Has anyone else questioned the moon landing One of the theories is that if you Google like the actual actual suit of the astronaut you can view the bottom of the shoe Really The soul of the shoe does not match the actual picture of the the footprints in the moon The footprints in the moon have lines going across the boot print and if you look at actual astronaut boots they don't have lines going across their boots And that's a that's a very big thing Like it's like how to answer that Rosa Linda has questioned the moon landing Who else has questioned the moon landing Capricorn one No I've never seen that Have you seen Capricorn That's a

moon landing movie J Simpson made it stop it He's in it That's awesome That's so cool I did not know I think he's been in stuff before Like apparently the um whatever that was What's the name of it I don't know You're acting you just you're talking like you've seen him and stuff Well I feel like he is Oh she goes Oh no not OJ Yikes Yeah he's in he's been in a Ford apparently a Bronco I'm just kidding That's not a funny joke I can dig it So that's why I questioned the landing All right What else have we got I'm taking a bite You want some more Never ever have I ever created a fake account to stalk another person on social media I 100% have done that I've never done that Really Was it a what I've never created a fake account Really You know what does it do Well my ex my ex that was a really really toxic dude I I wanted to check out the ring So the for his new girl and so I did create a um a fake account on Instagram but I realized that that was very immature and I deleted it instantly Have you you never Wow no reason to no reason to anything fake We got Keith Harris the experience and you love the black eyed peas You will love him He's incredible drummer producer Grammy winner writer don't go anywhere We're so excited to talk to him and learn all things music and um exciting stuff Don't go anywhere It's so exciting A AA A AAA So here is our Jari Unbox It you wanna get it charged up You use this fantastic charger over here This is the output over there and it has an extra cable like this with the ability to charge it in your car So that is really cool So we have it all charged up It has here you can press on the display you can see now that it is not drawing any power it is not bringing in any power and it is 99% charged which is cool So as you want to use all your separate things you can turn on the little lights and it will show you as you can see there that now you can draw power out of them or you can turn them off just like you would at home if you do if you wanna leave something plugged in but not having a draw power there you can turn it off So let's have some fun and see what our Jay can fire up So in the past we have used the Jari to light up our lives with go We have charged our cell phones and we have done a few other things But oh we've even lit up the Arrow Garden How amazing is that that we were able to light up the Arrow Garden But today we're gonna push the Jari to the limit and uh we are gonna take a look at the this works What's this This works That car vacuum Awesome Very cool And we could even take a look at Tabi used it And uh how amazing is this Oh my goodness You can just keep on going and going and going You can get into every little look and cranny in your car with all of this How awesome So this is what we're gonna do We're gonna stick it into our Jari I just do it this way so you guys can see what I'm

doing Turn it on it's a little light and the display have gone on because we are about to fire this up Thank you Mr Jackie There we go That is cool So let's see what else we can fire up today I mean that you can I mean that is just so cool You see powerful vacuum Jay fired it up Let's have a look at some of the other things that we can um fire up today Let's see Yeah we got it So let's try the LaVoy Air purifier I mean this is a high power drawing eye Item I think I would imagine So It's not something that you would generally plug into this little power port here Amazing if this works you know how incredible this must be So not only is the Jari used when you are camping or exploring the world in your RV or your car the Jay can also be your backup power source for a disaster Um You know disaster preparedness The Jay is definitely something that's a good day Listen I'm very excited today and if you're not getting that inside joke you're gonna find out very soon I'm Michelle Murad along with the lovely Kyle and we have Key Paris How are you How are you I am great Thank you for coming in a very busy schedule I try I try to stay occupied uh Over here Yeah So you are a producer a writer a drummer um known for incredible songs Like I'm a be there's a List Meet Me halfway like oh my God And then you work with Michael Jack like II I don't I'm almost like in a lost for words because I remember IAB when it came out and I was like I'll be like this and like I just like just like it was catchy and it was so fun and like what does that feel like for you know so I did a little a little stalking stalking googling not looking you up Um And just like just so impressed by what you've done But you knew that IAB was gonna be a hit Absolutely Because that was the name that was the name of the session the original session when I did the music I named it hit You know it's like uh I just got a feeling from it that um it was very different from anything the piece had done Um and I got inspiration actually from um I went to Snoop Dogg CD Release CD right CD release concert back in the day And that's why I got inspiration to do that song came to you It just came to you Yeah Love me You know what I'm saying It's that bounce that's the L A bounce I had to put in there but you're not from L A originally Where are you from Chicago south side of Chicago And when did you know that you were good with music Like when did you um I've been playing music What it'll be 30 37 years Uh I started playing at the age of 10 in church and um it all grew from there going to a performing arts high school in Chicago off to Berkeley College of Music in Boston And then you know getting the Black Eyed Peas gig and I've been with them ever since 2003 So this is my 20th anniversary Incredible I mean my big theory is we know as Children

what we want to do or what we're like drawn to because we're such a we're such a clear vessel of of just like inspiration and things And I used to have my own talk show when I was seven So it's called the Michelle show It was not called Michelle and Kyle because they didn't know Kyle yet It's called Michelle Good Day Live with Michelle and Kyle So cool Yeah I have so many questions So you go I'm gonna tap you It's your turn No I was I was really interested in uh the fact that you came from the south side of Chicago is that area just uh prone to having just amazing world changing sound producers and and sound sound engineers I would say Chicago is a nice uh culmination of both coasts you know uh we're not right as you know gangster as the east coast Well we're not as laid back as the west coast but I think it's a nice mixture of a lot of blues gospel soul mixed in all of that So that's why we get a lot of feel good music coming from Chicago and that sonically kind of translates That makes sense That makes sense Absolutely Wow Ok That just answered every question That's great That's great And you did know at an early age I was told uh when I was a kid right So they would watch I don't even know because I don't remember this So my brothers and sisters say like yeah we would watch TV Right And you would be nowhere to be found Right And then so as the commercials would come on I would run to the TV because it was music on my brother said that's what I used to do all the time And as soon as the commercials went off I ran away Like I don't wanna watch this So um I think from them watching me being a kid they knew that I was inclined to music and then like I said being introduced to church and having you know access to instruments because you know I you know we wasn't rich enough to get keyboards and drums Um You know they um saw my talent and they kind of invested in that They're like hey they would open the church just for me and my friend to go play Um and literally uh for me to go to college one of the members of the congregation cosigned for me to go to college So it was a very like strong community Yes Yeah So who's your biggest inspiration I would have to say well one of them I would have to say was my mom God bless herself Mom passed away before she got a chance to see any of my success on that But she invested in me um big time you know she saw it the talent Um my mother didn't like to drive on freeways or anything like that Right So um I lived on the south side of Chicago where I used to take piano lessons It was all the way on downtown Chicago So it would literally uh a 20 minute trip would take 45 minutes to an hour because she would take the streets But it was just that dedication that she saw that like ok I need to invest in my child because he I see something

special and she would even go out of her comfort zone to to help me achieve my dreams And at a young age you do realize that then she was going out of her comfort zone And then when I got old enough to drive she would make me drive There you go There you go I'm not taking the absolutely amazing That's so cool Oh my gosh that's so cool So she has a affinity for the mother stories as well Oh yeah I lost my mom um a few years ago and she didn't get a chance She saw the progression of things like going more like but she didn't get to see any of the real like she didn't I created a show and then she didn't see like she she said to me she's like make sure you finish that show Um And then from that show uh it opened me up to all these incredible actors and and then um next thing you know I'm on a set with blood and we have our own show and now we're talking to you and meeting all these incredible people So um yeah it's unfortunate but I do know that she's very much every part of this journey And um there are moments where like I was talking about her and something fell in the studio the other day So it's like I know that she's watching and she's very much part of the journey I want to know like so you you playing playing music at 10 Did you ever think that you were ever gonna be like with just like where you are now Like just you know honestly incredible artist only thing I wanted to to do was play drums right I didn't know anything about touring I didn't know anything about making music I just like playing drums and literally that passion for playing drums and playing music opened the doors to a lot of other things because you know I I didn't grow up around a lot of music producers because that was kind of still new like in the nineties you know doing synthesizers and computers like oh my God and Yeah Yeah Yeah I really tell my age right now But but yeah you know so a lot of that that journey just came from the passion of music and you know wanting to play and you know from that it spawned you know being able to travel around the world playing music going through about three or four passports playing Super Bowls World Cups White House a lot of pivotal events in history and um winning Grammys So that's amazing What does it feel like to win a Grammy It was kind of like the trifecta for me because it was like we were nominated and we won and then we actually played no I actually won We were nominated for that I won a Grammy for best urban alternative performance for a song I vocal produced for Chris Michelle and the Black Eyed Peas won a Grammy for best pop album That's amazing And I was a producer on that That's great What do you ever like have to like go back to 10 year old Keith and be like you got that like good job or like you know what I do I do because I like to

look at the journey like I have I I'm like a documentarian of my family because my grandma was that person She had old like uh Kodak film and all this stuff So I'm like oh so that's where I get it from So I go back in my pictures I'm like man I remember when I first joined the band I remember my first show I remember my first rehearsal I have all this stuff on tape And um I'm like this is it it's been really cool to to write these things down in college Really I was like OK I wanna do this I wanna do this I wanna do this And over my 20 year career I've accomplished just about everything that I wrote down So now me as the old man it's like ok I gotta write down some new goals you know because you never really as a young for her to think that you're going to do all of these things because it comes by so fast But when you get there and you look back you're like oh man I got to get some new goals Wow So what is what are on the new goal Oh we have a question One of the questions is Fergie still part of the black eyed peas Congrats to your 20 years Many many more to come on your journey Love that song I'm a be well I can't answer for Fergie I don't know I love Fergie death That's my sis I think honestly just life happens You know she has a kid you know a family and all that stuff and um I've never seen a pregnant woman to her Was she pregnant Was she toured No that's the point pregnant woman with a kid Like come on guys Like so you know life happens So if she ever decides to make a decision to come back on stage that's totally up to her I'm sure that would be um um you know embraced by all parties So cool How did you how did you how I was like trying to figure out like how did you get like the peace find you how how did you find the peas Like how did that Let's go back and so let's take a journey back in time Ok So 2003 Ok So what is Keith Harris doing in 2002 2003 I was a organist for my church in Boston He also played in a cover band in Boston but I lived in Brooklyn New York where I was doing most of my music production One of uh Puffy's hit man His name was uh Richard Young Lord Frierson So Keith Harris would drive to two times a week from Brooklyn to Boston once That's four hours one way and that's on a good day There ain't no traffic and no weather right So I would drive four hours to play for church for one hour drive all the way back Right Then come Friday And the weekend I play with a cover band called Felix Brown Love My Brothers So we would play all over New England So it would be Rhode Island It would be uh uh you know different spots uh Connecticut So wherever that gig was I would have to drive from Brooklyn to wherever that is play those shows Sunday morning drive back to Boston to play for church No church closer to you It was decent You know I just had that I'm a faithful

loyal guy I got he's giving you a hard time I appreciate that We would be in Vermont playing a ski gig But come six in the morning I got to drive to Boston because I got to be on the organ body level And then after I played for church Sunday service then I have to drive back home So I have to drive back to Brooklyn to go to my house We spoke when listening to you It's a ton of success and it happened really fast for you Were there any setbacks Absolutely What was like a what was the one that sticks out in your head that actually propelled you forward I think one of the biggest setbacks for me was the passing of my mom right Because like I said earlier she never really got a chance to see that But even during that time I had a really bad relationship that I was going through and that relationship was really holding me back from doing a lot of things because like I said I'm a loyal guy So I'm like man I'm gonna leave your ass behind Like I I wanna do stuff Yeah Yeah No no be with me So it was like fighting She was fighting for attention that I had to give my career but she wanted that It was kind of like a jealousy thing you know And um because my mom passed and a situation happened between me and that person that opened my eyes to be like you know what this is not good for me I gotta get out of this and ever since I made that decision it was straight up Yeah So ok so your mom did your mom pass when you were going back and forth for church Like when did she uh she passed after that Ok So yeah she saw all of that stuff So she and she and my sister would come and visit me in Boston in New York You know I treated her like yeah y'all come put her in the wall off Astoria You know what I'm saying Yeah because I'm coming to America I'm like yeah I want you to stay in the finest of hotels I wish I had the motorcade I didn't have I was like yeah y'all stay here I'm gonna show y'all a good time and back then you know Puffy was hidden So I would I would uh do dinner at uh Justin's That was his restaurant back Justin is back You gotta go back in time So you were so OK so I'm trying to follow the trajectory So you were playing at a church When were you When did you when was your big like moment It was it wasn't really a big moment It was more so like hey um a friend of mine from college introduced me to the the former musical director of the black eyed Peas Prince board Prince Boy lived in L A but he was in New York doing a show for another group So my guy Adam introduced me to Prince was like yo this is a drummer I need a drummer for the show So I hooked up with him did that show in New York with Prince Boy So we can in contact He went back to L A You know I'm still doing my thing in New York and Boston and then the original drummer and bassist of the Black Eyed Peas uh moved on

So when that happened he called me and like hey you wanna do this uh tour with us for the summer This is 2003 Wow this is when you're driving back and forth to church So it was to the point So the back story to that with the church side of it So the pastor was getting upset at me because I literally didn't live in Boston So I didn't miss a service I was at rehearsals handled my my issue with you He still had a responsibility Well issue with me traveling because he wanted to forfeit my pay to do other things for the church You know what I'm saying So when I come back and I'm just like oh there's a lot of TV sets around Yeah Yeah Yeah Nice By the way the spinning the spinners Yeah I wanna know Do you remember where you were when you got the call to like go and play for the black in my car driving naturally So I literally got that call I met with the the black eyed peas manager Seth Friedman He lived in New York So I went there to his condo met him He gave me like about five C Ds worth of music to learn I'm like oh how am I gonna learn this So literally learned it in the car Trevor I never really got a chance to sit behind the drums I just listened to it and my music retention was crazy back then because I was always listening to songs So um you know uh learned the music they flew me to L A um had a rehearsal with the peas for like five minutes They showed up like oh ok he's cool They left I'm like OK I guess I'll hear the songs and how it goes at the show and they still do that to this day They don't have And then sure enough my first show with the P was Coachella in 2003 It's awesome Your mindset is so profound Um I was listening to Samuel Jackson talk today and it kind of reminded me of you He was saying you know every artist starts out with huge aspirations as I'm sure you had when you were traveling between Boston and New York because that's why you were doing it Right Right But then you know as an actor I can say it's like oh I'll get I'm gonna get a movie and you don't get the movie Ok Ok I'll get a TV series Ok I'll do a soap You know what I could do a soap you know what all I need is one beer commercial and that would be just something and then it gets down to something And he said he said after I gave up the even the dream of the beer commercial that's when I got real serious about my my art because it was just about doing it It wasn't about the accolades and all that So did that happen for you Because I heard you speak earlier and you were like I just love playing music And so that's what really helped me So how how can you um give advice to the artists out there that may have that a little misconstrued right there Yeah I mean it's it's very tough in this uh social media area where you see a lot of things and a perception is not what it really is You know everybody wanna put their best moments to be

glorified to think that's normal But um it's the stuff that's behind the scenes and you know for anybody that's a winner or or accomplish a lot of things in their life they gotta have a passion for it because it's what you do in the dark That's where the passion comes in to practice and people didn't see that for all of my college years in the practice room a little hot box with my drum set in there when the radio playing along to songs reading sheet music making sure my left hand is a strong my right hand and making sure five different things at once going to school getting the education learning music and knowing what I'm actually doing and not just you know just being educated and learning my craft and it's a lot of time and work and money and effort that was put into my success right But I had to have a passion for it Not for the spoils the the spoils is the sugar on top So you were in that hot box right Playing and no one knew you weren't thinking to yourself Oh this is what's gonna get me the accolades You were just doing it because you loved it I was doing it because I love it and I was doing it because I had to because because I was surrounded by around a lot of excellent musicians So it couldn't be you know half ass you know I had to compete with the marketplace Where did that necessity come from That have to because didn't have to But you you had to but that was your own that had to come from the people that invested in me from my church OK So it's like I couldn't fail because they gave me a lot of support They gave me too much for me to be like oh you know I'm gonna f off and just do what I wanna do and just around like no people literally went to debt invested for me to be successful But you were like oh let me go get these accolades for them You were like let me just work hard Let me just be passionate because these people could have been my passion Yeah And because I love drums you know and I didn't really at that time like I said it wasn't no social media So everything was relative to my surroundings So I had a lot of peers and stuff that was going on tours and playing for big artists like Usher and Atlanta Moore said like a lot of different people But um they put in the time and the work and you know I'm like always like man when is gonna be my turn and I just OK I just got to keep practicing So when my time comes I'm ready there is no denying that I'm more than qualified for this job That was my next question Like how like you was you made up made it up in your mind that you were more qualified I deserve these things These things have to come to me I just need to do the work the necessary work to get my part to get there But I'm already destined to be there Is that a spiritual thing is that something your mom instilled in you or did you just innately have that kind of a belief system I think I'm an

old soul Um I think because of Chicago is kind of like a blue collar Like you don't get nothing unless you work for a type of place Um so that was in me but it was more so too just knowing my own setting my own expectations Where did that come from It just really just came from me wanting to be successful in whatever that is And I feel like you know it's all relative right I I didn't know about touring I didn't know anything about that I was successful being a cover man drummer I was making thousands of dollars a week Wow that's awesome That is awesome Like I said some perspectives perspectives that success But I always knew that I wanted something more right Because I was just like man I don't want to be 50 playing that No you know club in Boston you know and that's the the age old story of really talented musicians that get caught in a predicament that they can't get out of you know what I'm saying They're like oh you know you're one of the greatest drummers ever Why am I seeing you on at the corner juke joint playing You know because a access you know so I'm at Berkeley That's what you pay for is the access right And the network of people that you meet So even to this day I know people in very high places in their career we went to school together so I could just call them like hey I wanna do Xy and Z So it's that access to you pay for And then they also inspire you like they say iron sharpens iron So you playing on your drums and then you get off and you walk out your door and it's a whole row like 12 practice rooms And you could just walk right over and listen to the next guy You're like damn it it just dawned on me The first film I ever shot was in Brooklyn And uh we we just we had to stop we had to cut because we heard these drums playing in the air in Brooklyn We were near the botanical gardens and like I was gonna ask did you ever were you ever part of those those like huge drum circles in the park there No because I was playing for church They kept me up they kept you out the street they kept you out the streets I like it The street hilarious That is So that is I mean it's just it's just so cool And I mean I I hate asking this question because like but what's next You said that you wrote everything down What's next for Keith Oh But our our producer So we have a really uh good friend who's also co-host sometimes Um dr she I know you can't speak up on but she's obsessed with Josh Do you know she probably if she's watching she's melting right now I I have to I have to share the story She has because it was shared on the air She saved a fork from the restaurant that she that she used to work at He didn't I don't think he ate with the I think he picked it up and like she was like she was like I guess in high school when this happened she she blocked it and then they then they threw it somebody

threw it away and she was like she was like we were like why go for She was like it's an embarrassing story So we have to share that story Yeah Don't tell Josh I'm sure I'll feel like he's safe She's amazing What's that Oh what's that Oh ok So we got our producer saying he he said he's a good friend of yours I mean literally Josh and Fergie first met when we were on the road and he was an actor on Vegas So that's how long ago that was And you know they hit it off and you know he's been a friend mine ever since uh you know we've played shows in his hometown and things like that and he's a really cool guy I always been a nice great father We talk about our kids and stuff Like how many kids do you have I have two boys two boys What are their ages Eight and four What are their names Caleb is the youngest and Christian is the oldest Caleb and Christian What are what are two boys Like energy Lots of lots of energy Are any of them um inspired by what you do or are they into music Absolutely So when I have some shows in L A or some you know like close vicinity I'll bring them with me Um Actually my youngest son played a gig with me I had him on my lap when I was playing I got a feeling it was like the last song of the show So I was like bring him on stage So they roll a stroller and I I started grabbing the drumsticks trying to play while I'm trying to play I'm like I'm still at work So I oh that's great But that's going to be good for his brain Oh man his great memories And then my oldest son he would sit behind me all the time with his sticks and watch me play my gosh That's so sweet and did And I don't know if I heard this correctly You met your wife thing for the piece Is that right Absolutely She toured with me So she was a dancer for Fergie I love how everything is so connected Absolutely I just feel like when when you're on your path Things should come onto your path and not deviate you left or Right Right The courage to stay on your path Can you speak on that Just a little bit It's tough It's tough Uh especially nowadays like I said man I really sound like an old guy but if I had as many distractions with my phone 20 years ago oh my God I don't know My life might be way different It's it's just a lot of things that can infiltrate your focus And back then it was literally cell phones that just come out and you had a pager on No I no I I started with a nokia That's as far as distractions went you know So man it it it's really I would say it's really like commendable for kids nowadays that really find something they're passionate about and they can you know sift through the noise and really focus on what they want to do I think it's amazing And I think also too they have such a uh um a trove of information that they can use to accelerate their learning as well that we didn't have So literally I had to pay for all the knowledge I had to get Now

you could just go on youtube youtube engineering one on 1 \$80,000 That's true That's so true It's all about balance it's all about balance Um How do you balance your life That's a good question Um yeah I it's it's to a lot it's tough It's tough because you wanna give everything priority in its proper time because as a father I don't wanna be the guy that provides a really nice life for them But miss moments and they were like dad he was there But like but I got you a jet They're like no I don't even care about that you know I just yeah exactly So that's one perspective and then my wife making sure we have time as a married couple our wedding anniversary is next week Monday 12 years which is like about 50 in like I was not dating How long is it It's on ac No no no it's actually I joined this Uh I was the last member to join uh this family and I did because it is a family So do you feel that way Uh with the black family It felt that way Um You know the the guys will and um they are like brothers to me they've kept me around all this time and um you know it's nothing I wouldn't do for those guys It really is like family They probably feel the same way about you and you gotta be the GG everything together So wait before I want to know what they're doing for the anniversary we're getting we're like we're over the time that we're actually come on I love that Ok so I just want to read some of these I love your endurance and motivation to keep going You must be a Capricorn When's your birthday Oh no I'm a Virgo and Beyonce share the same Oh amazing It's striving for more and more and don't give up a dream until it becomes a reality Um and then there's something about the restaurant that you talked about Um but yes they they love your music We love you and and your story and would love to have you back Um we'll make sure leaves the home I bring my wife Yes Oh my God I would love that We love we are obsessed with that We are looking forward to meeting you Harris The experience is amazing having you on um where can people find you Keith Harris experience everywhere Um IG blah blah blah Yeah Keith Harris experience as you heard it here blah blah blah yada yada That that's what our producer does all the time You got to have music involved with Thank you so much for watching I hope you guys have a great day and um we will see you on Monday Enjoy your weekend Bye everyone Amazing Yeah you gotta get your wife off We have we have a best friend game which is like the newlywed game So we get to ask like you know like play games I don't know like oh a chance good morning and I with greater scarce and is in the want to be
