Good Uh I was a little weirded out earlier today that it was Friday the 13th Bye Why is Friday the 13th Like a thing I don't know Is it a thing I think it's a thing It's like well you know the horror movies I don't watch horror movies but you know of horror movie I do know of horror movies Friday the 13 of horror movies you know Friday the 13th I don't know enough about Friday the 13 I have heard of Friday the 13th that just took way too long But listen you've heard of Friday the 13th Yes today's Friday the 13th Ok Friday the 13th Do you know in Italy They don't have 4 13 because it's like saw you four hours ago Michelle what else is there to talk about Well it wasn't necessarily that oh you called me a little upset You were like Kyle where have you been I was like what do you mean Where have I been I was I was I just saw you four hours ago You were upset but you were like uh excuse me calling you Hello Oh ya I said Kyle I told Kyle about this Instagram uh video It's like a woman calls like a guy whether it's a friend or boyfriend or whatever And like the video is like the guy literally throwing all this stuff to answer the phone call and he's like oh I'm here I'm here I'm here I'm here I throw anything away just to talk to you like a pack of Dunkin Donuts He just like dunks on the ground Yeah Yeah Yeah Women expect these days and uh these days I think we just throw anything but that's what we're talking about Oh yeah Yeah But it's funny it was funny to me Are you comfortable sitting like this Ok I like the little like me up You didn't ask me what I'm doing this weekend What are you doing this weekend Moderating I got really excited I am moderating my very first moderator talk at L A Fit Expo this Saturday I will be interviewing um Olympic athletes Uh She along with Mr Steve Benedict I am very very good friends over at legendary will be there Um Listen if you want to learn more about health and expos go there this weekend You can meet me at the meet and greet we can take pictures and all of Yeah sign autographs I laugh But that's the thing Now it's a thing Yeah How do you feel about that Yeah Yeah Humble or proud Proud Yeah I uh I I have to say I want to give a special shout out to Mr Andy Waldman Um because I was struggling with a decision and I want to thank you too also for uh interjecting about that I um well I I had an opportunity and I wanted to be part of it but it was taking away from what I love to do and what I love more than anything It's content creation creating this show and making the show grow And now in full of my focus on what I want or focus on what I don't want Both Take the same exact energy Um You know just choose the cup half full view and stay positive focus on good things in life and make it a great day That's a good topic for today Given that we have a uh movie agent coming in Um I was talking with a few friends yesterday Same thing what they were like well you know they were sitting at the computer doing their odd job and just getting real down like every 30 minutes they just got like more and more uh upset and then we were talking and they were like oh well you know I think I'm just gonna get my real estate license because I can't handle this other job And I'm like I was thinking to myself well are you telling yourself because real estate takes about 2 to 3 years to really accomplish some like a a really good income from Are you are you are you telling yourself that uh you won't make it right if you get something like that I was like well why don't you just keep a job that pays you every two weeks and like maybe live paycheck to paycheck until you get the acting job so that you're subconsciously telling yourself like I'm just here for the acting But if you do a job that takes 2 to 3 years to accomplish are you telling yourself Oh I'm not gonna make it in 2 to 3 years for acting Subconsciously she was like just be careful of that Um But there's a balance because like everyone wants to live comfortably now But what were we talking about with Kimmy Seltzer about being comfortable with being uncomfortable And I think that's a big factor in this town and making your dreams come true You just gotta you gotta get uncomfortable

you gotta you gotta be comfortable with being uncomfortable I it took me so long to figure this out Um but I was driving on the freeway I like a voice memo to Andy and I was like I am so uncomfortable but I'm I'm gonna I'm good I'm good because I'm throwing my I'm I'm 100% uh-huh I'm glad you know what already happened by not being distracted by other outside forces You get you get stressed sometimes right All the time All the time Kay I feel like I need to kick you all the time Thank you for sharing yesterday I rewatched that episode Aspiring artist I'm not aspiring I am I think everyone's aspiring Kyle No I am I'm on a talk show This is our talk show What But that means I just have to align with it I'm not wasting any more time I don't think there's a negative connotation with aspiring Some people think of aspiring as like living in a van and uh like searching for aspiring It means that you're not doing it You even said this to me yesterday or the day before you were like Michelle you are part of this group You are part of the Golden Globe group Yeah Yeah So if you're part of the Golden Golden Globe Golden Golden Globe Group we should work on that before the agent comes in Did you how did you meet your agent by the way or how do you meet you Oh that's a funny story actually Um ok Well I go to a meet and greet I had a manager at the time who was not a manager now Um but uh this is like four years ago I had a manager suggest that I go to this meet and greet Uh I go to the meet and greet and um I'm II I meet I see a casting director that I had worked with previously and we were talking uh and then uh a man a man by the name of John Stoddard knew that casting director and starts talking to her Well the funny part is is that like we we're there to see a panel of these of these people speaking about the industry and they're let's say they're in front of us here Well uh my man John comes in and stands like right in front of John's just another actor who uh came to speak to the casting director that I knew and then ends up standing like right in front of me in between me and the panel and I couldn't see and and John's got like this you'll see John he's like on a in a bunch of movies He's got like this amazing hair do right And I was like hey Bob I can't see like I don't know Wait did you say hey Bob or I was like I kind of had like a I was like four years ago Yeah I was like hey Bob uh I don't know if you know or not but you're not invisible I can't and I guess like the attitude that I had he found really hilarious and he was like uh you know you have to meet my agent Yeah And from that interaction alone and you have to meet you're like a hilarious guy Didn't have crazy hair You wouldn't have your agent I didn't have attitude I wouldn't have an agent Look at that Wow You know Jamie Lynn Sigler from

the Sopranos Um Jamie Lynn Siegler from the Sopranos When she went to audition for the Sopranos she had like the she was in such a negative mood right She thought it was for a singing show and she found out it was like you know so she goes in with an attitude right All the other all the other teenagers went in with like they were like she went in with an attitude They were like you're hired Is that funny That's really good Isn't that great You know actually that's the same story for Patricia Patricia Keaton Patricia Heaton from Everybody Loves Raymond Same thing She was just clipping coupons She had two kids and her husband was driving nuts She's frustrated She's kind of going to another audition Yeah And then she went in and she had a little bit of attitude and she's like is this how long is this gonna take She looked right at the guys how long is this gonna take And they were like that's our girl That's she literally said how long is this gonna take me On the other hand if I was like that to anyone I feel like nobody would hire me No Well it's about the energy Like people will want to see if that specific very specific energy is that you could be a jerk Well no no no But like like you need like a little bit of every character has a little bit of spunk and the right kind of spunk If you see it in the person you're like oh that's it right there I feel like I don't I feel like my spunk is very spunk My funk is like I'm very much Emily in Paris Like that is like my world that I live in That's my world that I live in I'm all about creating movies and TV Shows like Darren Starr It's all about the aesthetics it's all about love it's all about you know you were in Charlotte Chronicles you know about Charlotte Chronicles or did you see know what do you mean all Like your juicy gossip detail She knows a lot of gossip but he's not going to delve everything No comment Ok You did tell me I can't ask you All right That's fair That's fair That's fair But yeah really good guy and like coming back to how we met So Jonathan Stoddard who was one of his great clients uh was like you gotta meet this guy So ok well this is well my expectations are very high It's an amazing agent So I was like this is the funny part So I go into the audition the first one and he gives me a commercial Read what I don't I don't remember but it was like I read it as if I was like in breaking bad I read it as if I was like in a dramatic series It was like a commercial Read it Like I give him this read and he's like well that's OK He's like well he's like but go back and like give it a go in the right genre of of you know it's a commercial you know no one's dead no one's you know but but he he ended up giving me another chance and uh we ended up you don't remember what it was for No this is like 34 years ago I remember moments like those like epic moment not a competition but I love it I swear

to God you're like this is what the brother from another mother and and Andy said to me the other day he was like you know Michelle it's not a competition I said I don't know it's just like this like thing where I feel like there's a little bit of competition but like not you're the only one competing I gotta be honest I know I am not like I already won Yeah Pretty much Like I wait didn't I make an analogy the other day I was like you're the hair I'm the tortoise It really is true Yes I move really fast Michelle comes in blazing I come in blazing hot I come in with sunglasses Completely quiet Like I know you've gotten better I have gotten better You've gotten better Let's skip the sunglasses down Oh I know we can see your beautiful eyes They're coming back Wait why I just lost my favorite pair That's really all the uh I hate to take it and like a in a in a uh sad topic but I definitely want to give it a shout out to the family for Lisa family sending a lot of love and condolences your way I know that must be really really really tough for you guys Uh but we're here for you and um sending a lot of love She was an incredible human and um the last I saw of her she was talking about how Austin Butler did a fantastic job um playing her dad and um she was uh she was there for the premiere and um um and all that But uh when I saw that I I felt a very uh very strong tinge in my heart So I want to send condolences to the family and friends of Lisa Marie and I know that Hollywood has been affected by that Um And she's part of such legacy Elvis I mean there's never been I think Harry Styles might be the closest thing to Elvis that we have Shout out to Mr Butler Uh Amazing job Incredible job Did you see the movie and guess what guess who's close with Lisa Um Cash Ho he posted a picture of those two together when he was like 15 or 16 years old Wow Wow Thank you so much for uh guest host for filling in for Mr Kai Blood while he was after could have done it Yeah I mean I am your parent aren't I Yeah you do the echo thing I do like have many sentences that are just me speaking I get excited when you say something I want to like interject That's why we're good I'm fine You're fine with it Uh We got the chat so we want to know what you guys are up to for this weekend Let us know what you're doing Um Again I'll be at the E A Fit Expo this weekend on Saturday Um Come visit me and my two new friends Olympic athletes Stephen Benedict and Miss Shea Um and it's gonna be a really really great talk So we're talking all about how you start your mornings Um And uh and all that jazz That's interesting That's interesting Getting in the morning ritual I got to get the morning ritual Yeah I I have to give a shout out I got this in Oh ok Not a not a show unless I I drop something literally 1000 on dropping something I didn't drop my phone yet I

said yes Um but this mug is really cool Um I have my oatmeal in it every morning Um and it asks morning questions Are you ready for the morning questions Ok What am I most grateful for this morning What are you most grateful for this morning I said you Andy and Natasha Yes nice You don't have to say it to me What are you most grateful for this morning I would say you're a show up Yeah Right Shout Shout out to PK A thankful for PK A Ok Um What would be my big win today Are you asking me Yeah a big win would be you know some days you just want to have like a good day like a like a solid day All I wanna have a good day What do you mean Just you know II I got my my friend my agent in here Yeah Yeah Yeah Having a good conversation with him would be a big one Yes that would be a great big win Who can I reach out to and send some love Ok Michelle I can send I can send out some love to Michelle Ok cool I hear about it if I didn't say it no I wouldn't do that to you I might I might later Uh what do I need to do That's what you get for being my friend man Um What do I need to be kinder towards myself for today I've heard that I've been like really hard on myself but I feel like uh really great people are hard on themselves So so keep the hardness What about you Ok Um I think just allowing space and grace for knowing that I am exactly where I need to be and that I am a perfectionist but just to chill the F out just to chill the F out That's going to be on my merch coming soon I choose me in 2023 You guys can be part of that and then I I'm excited for all the people that will purchase the sweatshirts the crop tops the hats and we're gonna have a group and people are gonna check in and let us know like all the amazing things that have happened for them after choosing themselves in 2023 Um and we'll do like little check ins and we'll have them on the show um through video and all that Uh maybe a very special guest Uh If you if you are one of the people that we choose will be on our show and you will be interviewed by your truly and the lovely Kyle true blood Um uh What deserves my energy today Am I answering this Yeah other than me No I'm kidding I'll take myself out of it I'm just I'm so consistent like every day is kind of monotonous in a way in this way like I'm just consistently consistent in having a good day Does that make sense Is that too boring Yeah kind of you know I actually saw this thing on Instagram where uh it was a round table talk Are you getting annoyed Not that easy though It's not just a show and to have a good day like you actually have to like put effort into it You have a good day Where's your grinch chat Yes you do I you said it to me yesterday You're happiest between eight and two and then afterwards the whole world is falling apart That's you for sure and saw

and saw a little bit of that the other day It's 2:30 p.m. is having a no I mean if I'm not doing what I love otherwise I'm like constantly creating a movie We're not talking about like a mental breakdown here I'm just talking about you uh focusing and getting a little bit stressed OK OK What do I need to remind myself of that Everything will be OK I love it It all work out What can I do today simply because I enjoy it I'll tell you stay here after the show working on um our Valentine's Day special which I'm really really excited about We're gonna have some of our favorite guests that have been on the show This is we've gone on to what over 100 and 30 episodes we've and we've got the wall of fame over there which is really cool and um really really excited to get some amazing people back on the show Um we're gonna have chocolate Oh there's gonna be chocolate Do you like chocolate I love chocolate Who doesn't like chocolate I mean I only like a cow Is that weird I feel like you're just saying that to feel like to be posh I think it's the dress I think it's the dress I only like a cow No no no no I like I like actually there's hu have you heard of hu chocolate I regular milk chocolate Hershey's from the supermarket aisle I remember I'm lactose intolerant Kyle Does that stop you Shut out the pizza by the way making the best Margarita Pizza on the west coast Michelle had more slices than anybody I did because I don't ever eat eat pizza You play that lactose intolerant card to your benefit For sure And then all of a sudden it's nonexistent when we have a Margarita pizza Fly in the door What It's Candace Nelson How do you say no to her She created sprinkles Shout out the pizza one more time She created sprinkles I remember in 2020 I was like so sad that I went like everything was closed But her sprinkles at m wasn't really So I went to her at M and I got like a double chocolate uh cupcake I only did it twice in my life but I got the both of them and I sat in the parking lot and I devout because I was driving Uber at the time and I was eating these chocolate cupcakes and I was like what am I knowing when I want Talk about one other weird thing that you do Sometimes Michelle will call me We'll be on the phone for like 25 minutes And I'm like I hear cars consistently passing by I'm like what are you doing Where are you She's like I'm in my car I'm in my car Are you driving No Where are you I'm in a parking lot It's been 30 minutes What are you doing Like you're wasting your life away Oh no no it's it's called decompression Ah you you decompress in your car Well not while I'm driving but when I get to my destination I was having so much anxiety that I needed to decompress before I went into the is it like the opposite of claustrophobia where you like kind of enjoy like the close space But I still

you know what I don't know but like I've always been like that ever since I was like little I liked being in the car Didn't we See We saw Sebastian Manco the comedian talk about his wife and he was like I'm out of the car She's still in the car I don't know what she's doing She's just chilling in the car I think I gotta memorize that whole joke because it's amazing you did the best Sebastian Ok So so but let's give the story If if you guys have seen this special basically what happens is Sebastian goes to uh dinner with his wife because my wife isn't good at going out to dinner for lack of a better word We parked the car I head out of the car I get out of the car open close the door Where's my wife She's still in the car I turn around What are you doing I do I come around the side she's got a hole outlet of Sephora Her shoes are off Ok Her dress is still unzipped and we gotta go to the restaurant What are you doing So so like she's like taking your time getting ready which is funny because I am that person but not that person Um I I'm ready Like when I'm in the car I don't take my shoes off when I'm in the car That's weird for me if I'm driving Right My funniest part is when he she was like talking to the bar back instead of the waiter Oh yeah Yeah Yeah And so he's like babe they don't know You got a here is the guy working in the back He doesn't need you you gotta watch the special and then wait wait the best The best is because the best is when um he like she's looking at she's looking at the menu and uh and the waiter comes over she's like oh my God Oh my God Didn't know I had no idea Uh I like I love this when they go You you go first Oh Yeah Yeah She goes she goes you first babe And then he's like no steak and potatoes back to you babe And then she's like uh and he's like how long did you think it was gonna take me to order You think I was gonna walk around the restaurant with this I that is one of my top top people I wanna get on the show He was just recently on with Sabrina Um Sabrina Selena Sabrina Yeah Selena she was on his show Uh daddy knows or daddy knows best Yeah Yeah She's so basically what they do is they have moms call in and they talk to uh Sebastian and the doctor full circle Selena is a producer I I have worked with on multiple movies She's been a guest on our show three times now She's doing comedic stand up two times two times Um Yeah she's she just filmed another movie Yeah which was just in variety and she was in Charlotte Chronicles and was incredible My brother told me I'm getting played off on let's get them on the talk show If you can tell I like to talk on We're so excited for Peter Peter My guy my guy let's get PK A Peter Yeah the agent Yes let's agency and uh and some fun stuff shall we Yeah we'll be right back We'll be right back Don't go anywhere So here is our Jari

unbox It you wanna get it charged up You use this fantastic charger over here This is the output over there and it has an extra cable like this with the ability to charge it in your car So that is really cool So we have it all charged up It has here you can press on the display you can see now that it is not drawing any power it is not bringing in any power and it is 99% charged which is cool So as you wanna use all your separate things you can turn on the little lights and it will show you as you can see there that now you can draw power out of them or you can turn them off just like you would at home if you do if you wanna leave something plugged in but not having a draw power there you can turn it off So let's have some fun and see what our Jay can fire up So in the past we have used the Jari to light up our lives with go we have charged our cell phones and we have done a few other things But oh we've even lit up the Arrow Garden How amazing is that that we were able to light up the Arrow Garden But today we're gonna push the query to the limit and uh we are gonna take a look at the this works What's this This works Vaca vacuum Awesome Very cool And we could even take a look at Tabi used it and er how amazing is this Oh my goodness you can just keep on going and going and going You can get into every little nook and cranny in your car with all of this How awesome So this is what we're gonna do We're gonna stick it into our query Let's do it this way So you guys can see what I'm doing Turn it on it's a little light and the display have gone on because we are about to fire this up Thank you Mr Jackie There we go That is cool So let's see what else we can fire up today I mean that you can I mean that is just so cool You see powerful vacuum Jay fired it up Let's have a look at some of the other things that we can um fire up today Let's see Yeah we got it So let's try the LaVoy Air Purifier I mean this is a high power drawing eye item I think I would imagine So it's not something that you would generally plug into this little power port here Amazing if this works you know how incredible this must be So not only is the Jay used when you are camping or exploring the world in your RV or your car the Jakey can also be your backup power source for a disaster Um You know disaster preparedness The Jay is definitely something that you'd want to have in your home And like God forbid there is something and the air is not pure and now you're stuck in your home You've got no power You can't put your air purifiers on If there's a huge amount of dust in the air or if there's a big um you know like we are in California there could be a huge earthquake will bring up a lot of dust but you obviously want to still keep your lungs protected Let's see if the Jay not only will give us power but will also save lives So plug it in over here we'll

turn it on and you can see let's actually put this up a little bit because you'll be able to see the lights So let's put that try and see if you can see that there Welcome back to Good day LA If you're new to the show Welcome Welcome I'm Michelle Murad along with Kyle Trueblood How we doing and we have the lovely Peter call and thank you Thank you for having me on the show Thank you for coming Good to see you again You too So you're this guy's agent What do we got Tell us all the juice I want all the guys are private private There's nothing private on a talk show Don't you know this no actually one thing I really do like about Kyle as an actor is he he doesn't limit himself He's open to any audition that comes in If it's nudity if it's same sex anything he's a professional He just goes he goes for it because he understands that's part of the craft It's not about your personal self You're portraying another character you're living someone else's life and he easily falls into it I mean he loves taking his shirt off I think we have a clip of that I think we have a clip of this if you haven't seen it I wanna I wanna show you what Kyle Kyle is such a great actor Um What happens here at Good Day Live Uh You just never know Oh Is this with the acrobats Yeah Yeah Yeah Yeah We had some acrobats come in and uh I stood on one of them and then he stood on me It was uh profound to say the least Oh here we go Let's take a look at Kyle giving it is all hilarious trust and communication perfect behind his head Keep his leg straight keep his leg straight right Make it like straight There you go Give him a flex Look at look at Kyle look at Kyle and then he stands on me but he was so quick to take his shirt off Peter like he was like oh you want to take my shirt off OK And he was just like the other two guys did I was like all right I'll take mine off It literally That's me freaking out I was like I can't believe I'm doing this The guy was cute That's all I can say I was like get off Are you holding him out I was like yeah he's 100 and £90 I'm 100 and 23 And then he was like about to flip me over and I was like oh I'm good And then k because he's like so overprotective he's like uh she's good She's good And we need her She puts the whole show together None of this like acrobats now on your next right He has been singing Oh Yeah Oh So this is hilarious So I like I had I didn't know I had a fear of singing I think it was like the second episode of this entire show We brought a karaoke machine out and Michelle's like loving it She's hitting her notes and you're like Kyle your turn and I immediately just start sweating like my whole shirt just turns like a darker shade And uh but now I'm like open I'm like I like open up to like singing everywhere and then just so this show's been very

therapeutic for me Yeah Like Peter was saying I kind of just go for everything I I mostly like to sing in the shower Yeah Yeah Yeah Like or when I'm home by myself I love to to just play music that I love and blast it and just like live What kind of music is that for You Peter It's mostly Greek music Oh yeah You're Greek Yeah That's awesome I wish we could play something but I love like nineties house music Oh there we go I got to ask did you always want to be an agent You know I think it was it was just a natural progression of my life Um when I was no I was born in Greece and then we we moved to Canada and then from Canada we moved to New York City and then from New York City we moved to a small town in Pennsylvania called Stroudsburg So my parents wanted to make sure that we understood the language and always kept it as our first language every summer They would send us to Greece So you know I'm fluent in Greek and I in those summers we my mom would listen to music and it it just had embedded in my head and I would always gravitate towards uh Greek music Well there was an artist that I really love I still love her to today Her name is Anna If you're watching and she's the she's the biggest star in Greece She's like the Madonna of Greece So um no no she's she's not that Madonna's not changes her look too but I would love her music so much I would constantly play it for my American friends Even though they didn't understand what she was saying They would love it and they would they would know the words because I played it over and over again So I think it was just part of my progression where it was like I'm selling the artist to someone and it started at a at a young age Yeah Sharing like I found this really cool person and it's like well sharing is selling is what I believe too It's like when you really love something you're not just like uh selling it you're sharing it And then um when I was young I from 1984 to 1987 I would record TV commercials I have like five VHS 12 hour tapes of just commercials I would Do you remember it the most That's oh there's so many there's like uh I don't remember There is one there is one that uh that one that I I always play around with my friends It is that one for it was like uh the pizza on a bagel but it was a pizza in the morning in the evening for for 20 years You have any time I mean like we all know it or or the um um the thing has been since the 84 It's been a long time I think they stopped running them in 89 So I would record these commercials for years and years Not thinking um oh I'm gonna be an agent and do commercials back then when I was 10 12 14 years old it was I wonder what commercials are gonna look like when I'm older compared to what they look like now So I I say I would record them to save it Not realizing that it was part of my my my trajectory in life's journey because when I first became an agent I was only doing commercials which I loved and I excelled at at a media Yeah Yeah Yeah You know and it and it it it's great because it made me feel powerful in the way that you know Coca Cola was looking for this You know I I would say I think these people would represent your product So when they would cast my talent I felt like I was making decisions that is our that's affecting the whole world like you're drinking Coca Cola because I thought this guy was great to sell that product So it's it it it's just an amazing feeling for me I really really amazing feeling I love giving people the opportunity to come on and like have them shine So like you're giving people like the opportunity to shine too which is really really cool How many how many uh agents in the industry do you have do you have this much passion about like innate passion for the for the business like that Right Well you really have to love it It is endless endless work and actors can be very emotional very sensitive And I've I've worked at many agencies before I opened up my my own and most of them I'm not saying most of them but a lot of them that I had met that you become jaded where you can't stand when the actors calling why am I not going out Do you have any back any feedback You know and I I can see how that wears on you because it's constant constant or they're like why didn't they speaking Can you find out why No I can't I can't That's not what we do right It's just trust the process So what could you say to those that are watching that are aspiring actors uh that want to get into the business or like how they could find an agent or like what's the first step they should do The first step is believe in yourself I love that Yeah Don't let other people or outside voices affect you because at the end of the day only you can stop you And I've seen this with a lot of actors where they get in their own way because of a fear in their head You have to remove that fear It's it's about becoming this other person Take those challenges Sometimes actors get auditions Like I can't do that I I well Leonardo dicaprio couldn't play special needs until he did You know Gilbert right So you take those risks You know the the worst thing someone can say is no what a lot of times people who are fearful I I personally call them and try to walk it walk them through it Explain you came here to do this this is an opportunity Stop blocking stop blocking yourself We were talking about believing in yourself before you came on the show about um I have a uh merchandise life line coming out called I Choose Me in 2023 Um And and we're gonna like you know follow up with all these amazing people that are buying the merch to see like what amazing things

have happened because they believed in themselves this year You know getting out of a toxic relationship pursuing a dream career all that stuff So that's really cool So believe in yourself you don't look at someone else who's already successful They have their own journey to get there And believe me when I opened up my agency I was dead broke Really There was a series of situations that had happened to lead me up to where it happened And then the day I opened I literally had \$400 to my name with no guarantee that I was gonna book anything I knew that this was this was your car I knew it I remember that day and I and I woke up and I'm like oh my gosh I am gonna fail before I even start And I'm gonna be the laughing stock of the town And then I something came over me and I said no I have my only option is not to fail I can only succeed And I just went forward with that And just my first month I grossed \$43,000 I didn't there was no guarantee So you just really have to go after you got you have to do the work And even when actors do auditions a lot of them they they become just they just they're just doing it I had one actress and this this is great She had she just was getting into it and she had one word for this uh show that she she ended up ended up booking the job I can't say it because it's not aired yet And the word was no no she was in an elevator Someone someone asked her a question and all she said was no but there was no direction We didn't know what was going on prior why who this person is I said to her listen to me do three takes and make them absolutely different Change your outfit in each one Do one take where you're so busy you're on your phone like and you don't care you're like no do another take where like why are you in my building Are you and then do one where you're flirting like oh no it's a good Yeah Yeah And she booked it because her intention I I no one none of the ones that we none of the ones that we were part of the show It was a whole other other scene wasn't but her intention got their attention Oh I love that So even when you were talking about Jonathan Stoddard yeah he um booked uh black Monday and the role was for a um drug dealing roller skater in the seventies Yes Nailed it nailed it nailed it But this is what he did We didn't even get the audition but it was a great role for him So that weekend he went out rented roller skates bought his seventies bathing bathing suit went down to the beach filmed himself roller skating doing tricks flash freeze frames all this He made this incredible video and we sent it in just to get the audition just to get the didn't even have the audition of course his intention got their attention So we got the audition and now he's in scenes with Don Cheadle Yeah Right So when he when he had the audition this was when it was in person because now everything as

you know is self taped the it was very specific wardrobe They wanted all white jeans white shirt seven like seventies white And where are you gonna buy white jeans now Right Right So he went to thrift shops He spent the whole day he spent like \$500 getting this outfit together We ripped the shirt He goes to the audition There was three other guys there and they were dressed like just like normal like nothing And John says to them um isn't wasn't there a wardrobe requirement They didn't care they didn't care who booked the job 100 So it's those little things and that's with everything in life If you want something no matter what it is make that effort put that intention forward and you can do anything Anything is the reason how how I met you and it was just that energy I could tell I knew Peter was a good agent because you could see the hunger in John's eyes and any you could tell it was in a certain way and you and John have had a relationship for how many years Six years Six years now That's awesome I love it so much Ok so believe in yourself Your intention gets their attention What what next Well when someone wants the when someone wants the job you can tell it doesn't matter if it's in acting if it's anything in life if someone makes that extra step you can tell immediately I love when actors come into my office and they did their homework on me and they'll ask me questions Like I know you have a daughter and I saw know that you know and like I remember it because I'm like they cared enough to see who I was and if we can benefit working together Yeah Your daughter must be How old is your daughter Eight years old I mean it's really good to have somebody like you to help her believe in herself And she does she have the bug No no she doesn't She wants to be a veterinarian She loves animals I tried to get her audition She's like I'm not doing it I'm not doing it So I have to like be like look if you do this job you're gonna make this much money then you can buy all these dog gifts Like I have to like turn around So it's like associated with that Awesome That's awesome But I do I that's I I make sure that she knows that And I tell her every day I'm like you're my favorite girl in the world You can do anything you want I'm here to support you Like I constantly put that in her head to let her know that she can accomplish and do anything she wants from dad vibes She's very sassy Eight year old Yeah I would hope she's sassy's Greek Gotta be a little sassy when you're Greek Um that's so cool Has she been to any of the sets Like for any of the actors that have booked things or not No she is obsessed with the show Wednesday Oh really She's obsessed with Wednesday Uh The good thing is it's my friend show So I called my friend and I was like can we go on set She went to oh he's like well we shoot in Romania I I tried watching the opening scene and I couldn't do it like the pilot episode and I was just like what like yeah did you see Wednesday My gosh this guy I didn't OK I won't I won't I won't say that I was with when I when I first when it was first coming on I had anxiety I actually went to the Golden Globes on uh Tuesday and I got to meet Evan Peters And I said look I I'm sure everybody tells us but you are an incredible actor You like you put your entirety into the role You can tell I said when I couldn't watch I said the first episode the second episode I had such anxiety so I just couldn't watch it And he just laughed He was like he's like you're welcome I did read an article about him Actually he was scared to do that role and then he just went with it as you were saying the committing and and just going with it he was like it hits you at some point like you're you know you're happy about being in L A and getting a job and getting the money but then it hits you that you're going to be living this life and and associated with have to get out of your comfort zone And he really did That's that's what makes a great actor is that you can step outside yourself let go of the ego and not ego in the sense of like in a negative way of course of your own persona and just be that person follow through with it I mean that's what people are attracted to watch because it becomes real it becomes attainable it becomes like tangible and you can understand it if you're that person you know with today where they where they where they went authentic casting I mean I understand that but at the same time an actor is to play another person's life you know and now it's like you know so the way that everything is going now so you're saying that a gay actor can't play a straight act a straight role because they're not technically I mean it's natural to me I understand the straight actor not playing a gay role because that should be because I don't agree He's he's thrown me I mean that's what he was talking about earlier where he's thrown me roles that were of a different sexuality and we both just went with it We were just like you Well the point is you as a straight man and you're going to play a gay role you want to understand that life you wanna feel and present it with someone who is straight can understand it Right Right Authenticity to it from a different perspective I guess the reason why I'm more like ok with like um uh the roles for people that are gay like goes to be more for gay people because that hasn't been like there have been so many roles that were not given to gay people because of so many different like biases And of course I grew up in that of course when I was back in the early nineties when I was an actor that was that was something I was scared of to say that I was gay because it was a career ending thing Yeah That's right You

know and it was like I don't know am I too feminine Like what You know and it and it's ingrained in your head I think it's wonderful that the freedom young actors gay people have today they can be who they can absolutely be open and free It almost makes me a little jealous that Like I I missed that opportunity I think Well no but like in my teenage years like I couldn't openly have a boyfriend to be in high school or like walk down the street You know I I remember like there was this thing where don't ask don't tell And it was in the news for freaking months and months and months and you know it's like why are we fighting this this guy wants to protect this country and you like want him out of the arm because it's stupid Crazy I mean this is only this is only changed within the last like decade you know big changes in the last couple of years Right Right And now now on all the roles every single role they they put you know it's open to all to gay straight transgender and courage which is great You want to give everybody an opportunity which actually led me to open up the first literally took it out of my mouth Queer division at your agency which is really really cool And it has been remarkable to this day It's been open for two years Now I get emails about it every single day from how many emails do you get Oh my God are we talking I have to ask So when actors are looking for representation what is the most annoying email to get from an actor that's looking for when they write me a novel And why they wanna be an actor How this is their dream Yeah Yeah We know it's your dream That's why you're here That's why you're contacting me Sell yourself Hey my name is blah blah I just did these commercials I'm looking for a theatrical organization I just did a co star on this show Here's my headset Simple simple just short short and sweet I I I'm not going to take the time to go to your links Download these pictures like the picture you know some some people are like crazy They like hi and they put like that It it is so funny and he was showing me uh just like some email about like looking for like people that were looking for investments and I was like this guy didn't even spell check or at least use any capital letters like what what is this It was just like one run on sentence It was like looking for investors for my \$500,000 feature film that I would like to have And I was just like how is this guy getting any money But I guess he might be that was gonna be my next uh opportunity to try this Hello How are you would like you to come in and see if you're interested in donating into my film 13 run on sentence It was a very long thing but um so cool So like keep it short and sweet Keep it short And sweet And the other thing actors who is they put like three or four head shots and

not realizing no you can put different shots I want to see different looks at it Oh yeah But they have the same exact expression on their face and it's just like they just change their outfits Show show me the characters be the young dad or or or or or be someone who's like cringy or like whatever it is Don't send the same thing I'll respond to those people I'll be like I don't know if you realize this I go but your expression on your face is exactly the same in every single picture It makes me think that you have no range Right Well at least you're responding That's really I mean I'm so busy now I just don't I just it in the beginning Oh yeah In the beginning I used to I used to want to make sure I responded to every single person but that becomes a job in it Oh yeah I just can't Wow So how many people do you rep we probably have about 1200 people on our Wow So you went from \$400 in your pocket to now repping 1200 people And you know one of one of our favorite people you rep other than Lovely Kyle Trueblood is Nancy Harding Oh we had on the show recently to promote the Crown Prince And we absolutely adore her so much Um And she talked all about like being in a state of gratitude because she said she got the most work uh starting from 2020 on because she would wake up every day and be like I'm grateful for this and this and this and then she just said like she booked like seven movie roles and then you know all this but like like a bazillion you know movie role like not bazillion but like it was like just going up and up and up and up and up and I was like that's awesome Nancy But she booked a commercial too like before the end of the year and and John does that too and I I do that too I wake up and I give I wake up really early in the morning like five or six and I and I no no one really starts contacting me until about nine o'clock in the morning So I know that that time is my me time No one's gonna call me I I'm not checking my emails because nothing is of that urgent So I I literally step out onto my balcony and I look up at the sky and because we always want things and we forget the things that we do have and how grateful that we should be for And I just do my grateful too I'm grateful I have my own agency I'm grateful I have my parents who support and love me I'm grateful for my daughter I'm grateful that I'm making money and I can take my daughter like on crazy vacations around the world I'm grateful my actors love me And if you keep doing it every single day you find oh many things constantly what you're grateful for I'm grateful I have a car I'm grateful I can eat out every night if I want You know it's just like simple things I'm grateful my sister called me today to tell me that she liked that picture Like it's just the simple things And then then I go into thanking God thanking the universe And I don't I never

say I want I want the agency to grow I say I will have my agency grow I will open an office in New York I will open an office I will it out into the universe I love that so much yesterday I don't know if you were here for this but I was telling Andy just like you know as I was getting a little distracted I had an opportunity that wasn't distracting from my soul and my core And ever since I was very very little I used to have my own talk show in my parents' basement And then I would create shows like in my parents' basement So it's always been storytelling for me like it's always been in you just like me with the even when I was a kid like you know when I would be in the bathroom a little kid you know I'd pick up the shampoo and I would read it like I was reading a commercial and me and my sisters to make movies all the time The same thing I did How many sisters do you have That That's awesome It's the four of you That's amazing What's it like having three sisters Well because I was the only boy I first born I was always the leader Yeah So you would direct everyone I'm sure in the place they'd always be like killer movies and for the credits and stuff we would take to paper and write like um killed by force or the movies and then starring and then I would film it and I would pull the paper like going down and of course we don't know how to it So we would just stop and then and then restart They they are pretty they're funny They're pretty good But we did 11 time where it was like we were cutting um my sister's head off So like I I was always the killer So the killer was like the the the camera guy like that was his point of view So we we put a wig on her and she lifted her shirt up We had a basketball and like I cut her head and goes rolling down the stairs My parents were like what are you doing Like what is that We don't know what to do I don't like you're making these movies Have you do Cool I I literally um have the me um hosting and I have to get the footage for Andy but like I'm literally like sitting at like this like table makeshift table with like makeshift curtains behind me because I had it was called the Michelle Show It was never the Michelle and Kyle Show because I didn't know Kyle obviously Um but it would be like all my do I would interview my dolls and be like uh today on the show we've got Barbie who just starred in the Skipper Skipper and Ken Although I know the Barbie movie that's coming out Did you see the trailer for that I did What were your thoughts I think it's over the top But but in a fun way Yeah I love it I'm so down for it Like the trailer was amazing It is directing isn't she Yeah Yeah Yeah The trailer is hilarious where all the little girls are playing with baby dolls and then they see like Margot Robbie and all of a sudden they're just like throwing the baby They're like I want that I was like of

course who wouldn't want that It opens like 2001 space Odyssey doesn't it I don't I don't know how it open Yeah They're out on the beach or something and they're they're outside and they're playing with these dolls Yeah Yeah Yeah Yeah they're outside playing and then and then Margot she comes walking and they're like they like they like burn the dolls like attack The dolls are like why should we take care of anything when we could play with something that looked like that Yeah that was me I never had baby dolls I was never taking care of anything I was just playing with the Barbies My sister's always had Barbies and all the time You were always a storyteller Do you ever submit your for uh roles now You know I don't I have no interest in acting Um I fell out of love with it in the in the mid nineties I had booked um Melrose place Wow So cool And we didn't really have cell phones back then They were kind of like being introduced Yeah Yeah Yeah So just the waiting around for hours and hours is what we were talking about I just I I wasn't about it I wanted to like do something I'm not you know the call time is like 6 a.m. and I'm on at 4 p.m. Well why the hell do you need me on Yeah Yeah Yeah That's the life of an actor So it just I out of it and when I when I was younger I was like I wanted to be an actor Like I was I I was the poster boy of my university the University of the Art I went to school for theater arts and they had this picture of me and I said I never wanted to be anything else It was like in the play Bills in New York City And it was like my thing And then I I just grew out of it I just but I love being an agent I absolutely love it I love calling that actor when they booked it And like it's the best feeling because I'm desensitized to it right now because we book so many jobs constantly I'm not like you know but I can hear in their voice and some crying they're like I love you Like you changed my life and it's like yeah well not really You you went in there and did the work I just opened that door for you It's you in Peter's office and he's got this list of people that have booked and every day it's a new list and there's like 30 people and it's booked I'm like what is going on over here And a lot of that is relationships It's the relationships with the casting offices as well And actors need to develop that skill too Don't you got Somebody said this to me I don't remember who said it to me It was a casting director and she said you have to look at uh one of my actors asked her how can I build a relationship with casting Now Everything is self taped Like how do I get to know that person And she was like you know follow them on Instagram like a post send a little message you know don't bombard them but just slowly build that You have to look at it as like going out on a date with someone for the first time If you say to that person I wanna marry you That's that's like no you have to get to know that person to get to that space And I tell actors all the time being an actor is just like working at mcdonald's I said this 1000 times you have to know you know you have to know how to use the how to make that burger because when you're the manager when that big opportunity comes you have to be able to understand those skills You if something happens you have to be able to understand what to do or how to adjust you know people come in and they're like I wanna go out for this and like it's not gonna happen It is a process just like with any other job people think getting into acting is difficult It's not the difficulty is there's no requirement so anybody can wake up one day and be like I wanna be a star Yeah Yeah So it becomes saturated with auditions from people trying to do this and it's hard to get through to a certain point as people grow They you know they're getting into their late twenties 30 I want to do something else This isn't working out for me but that person who is consistent and is there pushing and working for themselves They're the ones that shine through it It's just a process and it takes time It's a journey it's a journey Everything is a journey How much time do we have with Peter Oh yes Ok Well speaking of journey and a process we're going to play a game with you We like to call here red flags You a red one You're going to get a green one We just added the green flag Yes The green means go red means no here you go Um Whether you're date are you dating Single or we're not allowed to say maybe we pretend like you're single Ok Um And basically we're gonna come up with the topic Um or Kyle you can reach over and get the red flag Um I when Kyle was uh active well I I don't know what his situation is right now but when he was uh uh very much dating a ton um which I still don't know what the situation is right now Um And I can report back report back Although he'll say don't tell Michelle because she'll bring it up on this We were partying like a month ago and he has like a whole little entourage Like the agent has his own entourage And they were like it was it was you Jenny and like a few others And they were like so what's your deal And they spent about 20 minutes getting it out of what you say Uh well it was she's good at it It was like just before Christmas just before Christmas Oh something came to visit me and then I had friends that something happened before Christmas I think Kyle fell in love That's amazing Ok Ok Ok Just dating You fell in love Ok Ok Ok Ok And then I was like and he's like oh here gives me the best advice Like uh there's been roles and I I really gotta give it to him He will hit me up with like some opportunity with Fox that could pay for a

house that I never dreamed of like playing this kind of a character and I'll call him like uh Peter Do do you think I can play this He's like do you want a house I'm like yeah yeah 100% Let's do it I think I think you uh green flag would want Yeah he's always green flag He's always green flag I'm dating then it's a red flag because I I think it's a perspective too because I I I'm always optimistic and no matter what I I always look at things optimistically like I Well this happened Well that's because we're gonna do this Like I don't I don't block myself or stop myself and that's why you get that mentality I don't know It seems like that's neat Probably from your parents Probably Yeah because they were always supportive you know and my parents always took care of me and my sisters They paid for our college Like they just always do what you want to do Be happy Like just always embedded in us And then when I would meet other people where they came from these broken families I would I thought they were because it was completely not my experience a great experience you had and continue to have that Um What do you got Um No no no no Just just we can't do it and say no just go for it Some of them are just ready Flags are moving Yeah we're ready We're ready But if you put them up oh wait what Drinking a lot Drinks a lot of what Alcohol Why are we High five That's when it gets fun That's fun Right That's right Right I'm with you on that I'm like drinks a lot Sounds fun Do you want your lady to be drinking a lot Oh now you're rethinking this Well only when he's home Like II I didn't know how to say it without being misogynistic about that Are you misogynistic about Kyle Uh steals locks of your hair red flag But you like that I mean they're obsessed with you Oh I knew that that we're both like oh yes But we have to kind of want that from them too We don't want the wrong person So that's like there's nothing worse than when the wrong person is obsessed with you Have you have you had a wrong person obsessed with you I think we all have at some point like like you're like you're dating someone like oh this may not be right But they're like going full force You're like oh wow Yeah Right No no no no no no Uh it doesn't make any sense Just read it out loud I really won't talk to you if you're part of the wrong hogwarts house I no that's the question Yeah No I mean just say it that's that's out of my age I like Harry Potter I was uh her for oh she's a good advertising executive She or he he sure he world's best advertising executive of course Yeah Yeah Yeah Ok You're not you're not playing anymore No I am I am I was curious on it I was a little I was a little deterred only because she knows if you're a really good salesman she knows how to she knows how to sell herself But are you getting what you expect it

If you're the world's best advertising executive I assume you're good at what you want This is kind of like this is kind of what people say about actors I don't know why I'm even doing this because like people do this about actors It's like well if you're a really good actor like aren't you just lying all the time It's like whatever that comes from an amateur Yeah Ok I'm gonna I'm gonna say that although I will say like if I was uh married to someone or dating someone and they were hooking up on set like uh like for the role not stop they're like totally making out with a super hot person It would rub me the wrong way Yes of course It would rub me the wrong way But I know that that's like part of the job and you have to you have to be in that state of mind understanding that that this is work That's so funny I actually had a conversation with John about this because I asked him I said has anyone ever expressed feelings to you Because he does all these love rom com movies He's always you know they follow love and there's a lot of kissing and he said one time that one actress did express interest and he said I understand that that emotions can happen but we have to understand like this is a scene This is not real John's really mature Yeah Yeah What do you All right I'm looking for a good one I want the good one has a bod like he man raise them Come on Who doesn't want that portal has an Iron Man suit Captain of the Enterprise Your favorite Power Power Ranger Uh is your favorite fantasy character Most amazing cos player you've ever met Green Air traffic control over here We are coming in for a landing You can't even say that one on air No we cannot actually Well you know Yes I know what that means Don't can can only complete with a complicated 14 button combo move Oh I mean it depends How is it Like I think that's more female for me Oh that's not true That's not true Yeah True true It's actually just an escort is actually just an escort I mean sometimes Yeah I know it I know it Yeah Yeah Depends He's he's here for the fun I'm here for we're here to enjoy life Yes we are You know that's so funny You bring that up because um with with me I always I always associated love with sex It was never there there wasn't a uh a departure from it It was always associated together and someone once said to me like a long time ago like sex is can be a pleasurable thing Like having fun going out to dinner and I never looked at it that way Yeah Yeah So yeah bring those escorts I love it It's it's a way it's a way of looking at life is always covered in ants All right Civil war Wait no wait slow down Basic red uh charges you a quarter Every time you say a curse word charges you every time you say a curse word Where is the quarter going I'm from Jersey Where is the quarter going Like is it going towards like date night Is it going to like

a trip like you know like something That could be cool I mean how how old are they Right Right Right Right Like 35 years old like when he said something the other day I was like you need something Right Yeah I said I said a lot of stuff Uh why you give me here I'll do you know what Don't don't play us off here We're having too much fun Ok Has not dated anyone in 10 years That's your like number one That's a that is I would wanna know why why sometimes people go through things and they and they need time for themselves II I had I had a period of time in my life I got where I didn't date anybody for like five years five years five years And it was I just had to re I I wanted to focus and just change things because you know we we all we all go through things in life and and we experience like there was a time in my life where um monogamy was not important to me Right You know and I and I would have 23 boyfriends and they it was always problematic you know and and I never realized that how I was affecting them emotionally from it You know And now I'm older so monogamy is important to me Right Right Right Um this is the last one and then you can play us off calls their pet their Children I mean that's kind of cute Thank you That's a good one I've been I call my dog my daughter I mean I would call my dog my baby Yeah Yeah he has a daughter or my baby I love it I'm backed up on this one All right Peter Thank you Stay true to stay true to yourself Follow your dreams and never give up because only you can stop you and love it And then how can people get in touch with you if you want if you want more clients Yeah you can find me on Instagram Peter Caterra Agency or hashtag PK A Um Yeah reach out We well we love talking to you Um I was gonna ask more questions about Kyle but I feel like that you know we got on the hot spot um hot spot hot seat Uh Thank you so much Peter for being our special guest today Thank you Wherever you are today I hope you find the good in your day and spread it to whomever you may You guys have a really great weekend We'll see you guys live on Monday Let's have a good weekend I like this I like like for our landing a chance and I guess
